Pick up instructions will be given when the application is filled out and this year the parent picking up must have a driver's license (or valid government issued ID) with the address matching the application or a current utility bill with the physical address that matches the application. Also for each child the parent must bring a birth certificate or a local school report card for this semester.

The ages served are birth to 16 years.
