# Ordering Driver Records

An individual can order a driver record online or by mail, Driver records are not available in driver license offices.

#### Order Your Driver Record Online

You are eligible to request Driver Records online if you are requesting a Texas Driver Record for a Non-Commercial or Commercial Texas Driver License or a Texas Identification Card. Your browser must also support 128-bit encryption. You must be able to print at the time of the request, and will need access to a printer.

Information needed to request a driver record through this service:

- Your Texas Driver License
  - Driver License Number
  - Current license audit number
- Date of birth
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security Number
- · A valid credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Discover, or American Express)
- · Understanding of the type of Driver Record you need
- Adobe Reader (Download Adobe Reader)
- · Access to a working printer

# Order a Driver Record by Mail

To order a type 1, 2, 2A, 3, 3A, or certified abstract (type AR) of driving record by mail, follow the instructions on the **driver record** request form (PDF).

If the driver record has not been received three weeks after the date it was ordered, contact **Customer Service**.
